**We want to see you Better Campaign**  
\$196,905 was raised to enhance radiology services in the Tantramar region.

**2008**  
**Donate for Dignity Campaign**  
\$66,091.15 was raised to enhance care for seniors at the SMH by moving towards an "Elder Friendly" hospital providing a physical environment that is most beneficial to older adults.

**2005**  
**Healthy Returns Capital Campaign**  
\$284,000 was raised to purchase a range of urgently needed medical tools including two defibrillators, a wheelchair scale, microscope, blood bank refrigerator and several specialized beds.
